Listen & adhere to the safety talk rules

No dogs, personal knives or tools to be brought to Forest Church without contacting the team ahead of the session.

Forest Church meets within a set, designated site. If you go outside of this site you are not covered on insurance. This site will be highlighted to you at the beginning of a Forest Church session.

Please dress appropriately.

Please inform us of anything we need to know including allergies, illness, health, pregnancy or any recent relevant events that may affect the behaviour or safety of any member.

By attending this session you are agreeing to these conditions.

Please inform us if you leave early so that we know in case of emergency.

Parents are responsible for their own children's behaviour but team will support wherever possible.

All activities are thoroughly risk assessed before the start of each session and Leaders continue to monitor the safety of the group as activities progress. There is always a trained first aider present at each session and a written emergency plan available on our website & in the outdoor file with Forest Church leader.
