## **Discussion Questions**

- What stood out to you in the talk and why?
- In this passage, Jesus continues to train his disciples for a distinctively Christian lifestyle. Do you think the issues Jesus should form part of training for discipleship today? If so, how can the subject best be approached?
- David talked about five 'tactics' for halting the slide from looking at someone, to lusting after them. Discuss each one and evaluate its usefulness.
  - Reframe your relationships (1 Timothy 5:1,2).
  - Remember whose you are (1 Corinthians 6:15-20).
  - Remove the poison (Job 31:1)
  - Recruit support (James 5:16)
  - Ring-fence sex (Hebrews 13:4)
- Are there any other 'tactics' that you think should be on the list?
- David explained that 'hell' (Gehenna = Old Testament 'Valley of Hinnom') was a real place associated with great evil, the loss of God's approval and with destruction (Jeremiah 19:1-6). It's not just sexual sin that, according to Jesus, leads us to that place (Matthew 5:22).
  - Why is sexual sin so corrosive of our relationship with God?
  - Is there a danger in viewing sexual sin more seriously than other sins?
